You are also exposed to the basics of instructional design.

This is a requirement for IDI Level II and can be used toward the 3 year instructor recertification. This course is designed for those who need to complete their Level II IDI training or for those who need to be recertified. Do not take this course if you are enrolled in or have taken the 40 hour Level II Core Course as this will be redundant information.

Requirements: Completion of AICC (Level 1) or its equivalent. Laptop computers are highly desired.
